**What** to Bring: All-day bike with climbing gears, helmet, I.D., spares, device, CDL, Camelback/bottles, sunblock, first aid kit, funds, tubes, pump, current [ACTC.org](http://actc.org) membership, route sheet/upload, compact sleeping roll may be required if Brian says so, Govt. I.D./CDL (required at the Military Checkpoint to enter the Fort Hunter Liggett! Mark your bag with your name and keep it closed).

**SAG** Vehicle: Carries your SMALL, soft and compressible overnight bag (please NO rigid carry ons, luggage, rolling cases or duffle bags that are >30" long)

### **Rest Stops:**

Saturday: ~85 miles, Nacimiento Billy Goat. Point Sur Lighthouse Gate (snack), Pfeiffer Big Sur State Park Lodge Parking Lot (SAG sandwich lunch), Lucia Store Restrooms (snacks, water), top of Nacimiento Fergusson Road (snacks, water), Hacienda Guest Lodge Dining Veranda (Saturday's group dinner).

Sunday: ~85 miles, Carmel Valley and optional Cachagua Loop Billy Goat. 8 am start after clean up and breakfast at the Hacienda. Starbucks King City (ice and DIY coffee), Arroyo Seco Road intersection with Elm under the Big Oak past the Green Bridge (sandwich lunch), top of Carmel Valley Road unmarked open shoulder barbed wire fence near the cattle grates (snacks and water), Carmel by the Sea Safeway Finish!
